COUNTY DRAIN PETITION

(Drain Code of 1956, as amended MCL 280.191)

“LAMBERT COUNTY DRAIN”

At a meeting of the South Haven Charter Township, Van Buren County Michigan, held in said Township on the 9th day of December 2015 at 7:30 PM.

PRESENT: Kiry, Jessup, Stein, DeGrandchamp and Wiatrowski

ABSENT: Fisher and Bertorelli

The following resolution was offered by Kiry and seconded by Wiatrowski.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township of South Haven, County of Van Buren make and cause to be filed a petition in form substantially as follows:

A petition is needed for cleaning out, relocating, widening, deepening, straightening, tiling, extending, consolidating, relocating along a highway or requires structures or mechanical devices that will properly purify or improve the flow of the drain or pumping equipment necessary to assist or relieve the flow of the drain, or needs supplementing by the construction of one or more relief drains which may consist of new drains or extensions, enlargements, or connections to existing drains, or needs 1 or more branches added thereto as may be required for the maintenance and improvement of the drain known and designated as the **Lambert Drain**, located and established in the Charter Township of South Haven, County of Van Buren, State of Michigan.

Your petitioner's further show that the said drain needs extended and a branch added to better alleviate the flooding and facilitate storm water flow into the Lambert County Drain, and to further determine whether the addition and/or deletion of lands as recommended by a licensed engineer or surveyor will more accurately define the boundaries of the land benefitted by the Drain, and whether such addition and/or deletion of lands is just and equitable pursuant to Section 197 of Act No. 40, P.A. 1956, as amended.

And such drain is necessary and conducive to the public health, convenience or welfare of South Haven Charter Township (Michigan Drain Code, MCL 280.191 P.A. 40 of 1956 as amended, Chapter 8)
