ORDINANCE NO. 5-98 RESCINDING OF PLUMBING CODE ENFORCEMENT ORDINANCE

An Ordinance to designate an enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of Bloomingdale Township under the provisions of the State Construction Code Act, being Act 23 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

BLOOMINGDALE TOWNSHIP ORDAINS:

Section 1. RESCINDING OF ENFORCING AGENCY

The Building Official of Bloomingdale Township will no longer be designated as the enforcing agency for the Plumbing Code to discharge the responsibilities of Bloomingdale Township under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended.

Section 2. ENFORCING AGENCY

Pursuant to the provisions of the State Plumbing Code, in accordance with Act 230 of the Public Act of 1972, as amended, the State of Michigan is hereby designated as the enforcing agency to discharge the responsibilities of Bloomingdale Township under Act 230 of the Public Acts of 1972, as amended. The State of Michigan will be responsible for the administration and enforcement of said act throughout its corporate limits.

Section 3. PUBLICATION

This ordinance shall be effective immediately after legal publication in accordance with the provisions of the BLOOMINGDALE TOWNSHIP Charter and Act governing the same.

Section 5. SAVING CLAUSE

Nothing in this ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding in any court, or any rights ACQUITTED, or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.
