Ordinance # 4

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT A BREACH OF THE PEACE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR BY ANY PERSON MAKING OR ASSISTING IN MAKING ANY NOISE, DISTURBANCE, TROUBLE OR IMPROPER DIVERSION, BY WHICH THE PEACE AND GOOD ORDER OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR ARE DISTURBED AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF IN THE TOWNSHIP OF BANGOR.

The Township Board of the Township of Bangor, County of Van Buren, and State of Michigan, ordains:

1. The following requirements shall apply to all persons located within the boundaries of the Township of Bangor, County of Van Buren, State of Michigan.

2. BREACH OF PEACE: No person shall make or assist in making any noise, disturbance, trouble or improper diversion, by which the peace and good order of the Township of Bangor are disturbed.

3. This ordinance specifically excepts disturbances from normal agricultural practices.

Any person convicted of violation of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not to exceed \$500 or imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed 90 days, or both, in the discretion of the Court. In default of immediate payment of such fine and costs, such person shall be committed to the County Jail until such fine and costs are paid but not more than 90 days.

This ordinance shall become effective on Sept. 20, 1977.
